The land is ready. Permits have been obtained and ground broken. The Orange Rotary Club has donated funds for the well. This will be the 24<sup>th</sup> house built by Orange County (formerly Rapidan) Habitat for Humanity...built in cooperation with partner families and with community support like yours.

Funding is desperately needed to buy the building materials we cannot get donated. Skilled labor is also a great need.
